The main difference between the Daintree Seat and its recycled plastic sister the Kimberley is in the Daintree's additional seat slat on the horizontal plane. To accommodate that enhancement, the supports transition to the vertical on a sharp angle rather than a curve.

This extra slat gives the Daintree Seat that little bit extra substance and seating support, where the lighter Kimberley may not quite meet the user group needs.

As with the Kimberley, the Daintree Seat comes in three stock lengths. It is often installed with powder coated steel arm rests affixed, for even more comfort.
